Sub.: Extension of last date for receiving application for Increase of MBBS seats to implement EWS quota - reg.

Madam / Sir,

This is with reference to Ministry's letter No. U.12012/350/2019-ME-I, dated 24.06.2019 granting approval of the proposal of BoG, MCI to extend the benefit of additional seats under EWS quota to the colleges which are being run by Government controlled Societies, Municipal Bodies, Public Private Partnership and under Self-Financing mode, and these institutions (a) provide reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC, implement reservation guidelines of State, (b) charge fee fixed by the State Government and (c) also contribute 15% of seats to All India Quota(AIQ).

2. In view of above, it has been decided to extend the date of receiving application for increase of MBBS seats to implement EWS quota to the colleges which are being run by Government controlled societies, municipal bodies, public private partnership and under self financing mode which also follow reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC, charge fee fixed by the State Govt. concerned, and also contribute 15% of seats to AIQ, as specified above.

3. It is further stated that a fresh window of opportunity is given to all States to submit proposals for enhancement of seats to implement EWS quota in colleges as specified in the preceding paragraph. In case reservation policy of State Government is followed only on some of the seats in the colleges, additional seats to implement EWS quota will be sanctioned only with respect to those seats.

4. State Govt. may send their proposals accordingly for providing benefit of 10% of EWS quota.
5. It is also requested to intimate the reservation percentage of the State for all categories of reservation implemented for admission to MBBS course along with the proposal.
6. All such proposals must be duly recommended by the State / UT Govt.
7. Last date of submission of such proposal is **again extended to 28.06.2019** to receive application for increase of MBBS seats to implement EWS quota to the colleges which are being run by Government controlled societies, municipal bodies, public private partnership and under self financing mode which also follow reservation of seats for SC/ST/OBC, charge fee fixed by the State Govt. concerned, and also contribute 15% of seats to AIQ.
8. State Governments may kindly bear in mind that this increase of seats is for implementation of EWS Quota, therefore, fee structure for EWS Quota students must be within the affordable limit of EWS categories with reference to criteria fixed for identification of EWS beneficiaries.

Sir,

Please refer to earlier communication even letter dated 18.04.2019 about submission of application for implementing 10% EWS quota for undergraduate seats in medical colleges in your State/UTs.

Medical Council of India vide letter dated 20.05.2019 had extended the last date of submission of the application till 07.06.2019. However, it is observed that MCI is receiving requests for some more clarification from most of the States regarding the scheme of increase of seats under EWS quota.

In this regard, please find enclosed herewith a "Guidance Note" about process to be followed along with the prescribed proforma as annexe for submission of application to MCI at the earliest. The last date of submission is again extended to 11.06.2019 so that all the intending States/UTs may avail this opportunity for providing benefit of 10% EWS quota for students of their States/UTs.

**GUIDELINES FOR CALCULATING ADDITIONAL SEATS FOR IMPLEMENTING 10% EWS QUOTA
FOR MBBS COURSE**

For 10% increase in seats for EWS quota, following are the guidelines to facilitate its implementation:

- (1) The MCI would increase the seats for implementing 10% EWS quota.
- (2) This increase in seats would not entail any corresponding increase in infrastructure or faculty right now. Periodical assessment would be done at stage of 1st Renewal, 4th renewal and recognition stage. The periodical assessments at 1st & 4th renewal would be advisory in nature till the stage of recognition inspection.
- (3) In order to implement the 10% EWS reservation quota, the increase in seats has to be effectively 25% of the current intake to ensure that the existing number of general and other quota seats are not affected. Thus a college with current intake of 100 seats would need to add 25% additional seats i.e. 25.
- (4) The calculation of seat increase has to be made taking into consideration the total intake of students at the "State" level considering all the seats / institution where the Government reservation policy is applicable and is being implemented.
- (5) The overall increase is to be calculated on basis of 2019-20 approved / permitted seats and will can be implemented over a two year period i.e. 2019-20 & 2020-21.
- (6) In the first phase the increase will be applicable only in colleges with approved / permitted intake of 200 or less.
- (7) The increase in seats matrix would be as below:

Intake	25% increase	The applicable MSR at the stage of recognition
50	62	50
100	125	150
150	187	200
200	250	250

- (8) The Consent for increase in seats applicable will be received from the State Governments to the MCI latest by 11.06.2019, so that the MCC can be informed by

15.06.2019 for inclusion of the increased seats for counseling during the current admission year 2019-20.

- (9) The format for providing the said information is provided in Annexure-I. The State has to first calculate the additional seats that are required for implementing the 10% EWS quota and then using the format and matrix provided in Annexure-I, ascertain the colleges where the increased seats are required and indicate the same while submitting the request to the MCI. **The MCI will not grant more seats than the amount calculated for implementing 10% EWS quota, even if, the State has more capacity for intake.**
- (10) The State Govt. who have already submitted the proposal for increase in seats may resubmit the same, in case they so desire, taking the above scheme for increase in seats as per the proposal.

Table for calculating increase in seats for implementing 10% EWS quota

Guidance Note:

- (i) For colleges with an intake of 50, 25% increment would result in 63 seats. However, the college can make a request for 75 or 100 seats.
- (ii) For colleges with an intake of 100, 25% increment would result in 125 seats. However, the college can make a request for 150 seats.
- (iii) For colleges with an intake of 150, 25% increment would result in 187 seats. However, the college can make a request for 200 seats.

Dated 04.04.2019 - pursuant to revision of Teacher:Student ratio, for which the college/Institution is required to submit application for starting/increase of seats in PG courses u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 alongwith prescribed fee, Consent of Affiliation etc. by 15th May, 2019 which was further extended to 30th May, 2019.
2. Dated 18.04.2019 – Implementation of reservation of 10% seats to Economically Weaker Sections (EWS) candidates by enhancing of PG seats in existing Govt. medical colleges for which Colleges may apply through DME alongwith information in the prescribed proforma. It is further clarified that this scheme for EWS Quota is being implemented to implement Constitutional Amendment and is applicable to both permitted and recognized courses in pursuance of Central Govt. letter No.V.11025/10/2019-MEP, dated 29.01.2019 (copy enclosed). Other supporting documents as required for consideration u/s 10A are not required to be submitted for consideration of increase of seats under EWS scheme.

This notice is issued to clarify that above mentioned matters are different and should be treated separately. Further, all Govt. institutions concerned are requested to submit their applications accordingly.

Kindly refer to your letter No.V.11025/10/2019-MEP dated 9th May, 2019, forwarding there with D.O. letter dated 09.05.2019 received from Govt. of Madhya Pradesh regarding the above quoted subject.

This is in continuation of Council circulars dated 12.04.2019 & 18.04.2019 on the above mentioned subject. After reviewing the response to the said circular, it has been decided that the proposal for seat enhancement for EWS scheme be extended to the govt. medical colleges that are likely to be granted Letter of Permission and also to those medical colleges which are in the stage of renewal of permission.

It is further clarified that the ambit of this scheme is applicable to:

1. Government Medical Colleges that are likely to be granted Letter of Permission in the academic year 2019-20 for admission of 1st batch of MBBS students.
2. Government Medical College which are in the state of renewal or permission for admission of fresh batch of MBBS students and
3. Government Medical College of which MBBS degree is recognized.

Keeping in view the fact that the last date for grant of permission for establishment of new Medical College is 31st May, it has been decided to extend the date of submission of proposal under EWS scheme to **7th June, 2019.**

Further to this office Circular dated 12/04/2019 with regard to implementation of reservation for EWS for admission to PG courses in Government Medical Colleges under the control of State Governments, I am to request you to send your proposal under the EWS scheme in consultation with DMEs u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2020-21 not later than 15th of May, 2019. In this proposal, the increase of 10% EWS quota should be on the seats that stand recognized on the day of submission of the proposal.

The proposals for increase of seats u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 (Other than EWS - Regular Application process for Increase of Seats) as envisaged under The Opening of a New or Higher Course of Study or Training (including Post-graduate Course of Study or Training) and Increase of Admission Capacity in any Course of Study or Training (including a Postgraduate Course of Study or Training) Regulations, 2000 should be made separately.

You are also hereby requested to send proposal under the 10% increase in MBBS seats under EWS scheme in consultation with concerned institutions u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year **2019-20**. In this proposal, the increase of 10% EWS quota should be on the seats that stand recognized on the day of submission of the proposal. Colleges to ensure that the additional facility required for the increase as per the Minimum Standard Requirements for the Medical College for 50/100/150/200/250 Admissions Annually Regulations, 1999 shall be put in place by the time the said increase in intake capacity of the college comes up for recognition. The college-wise MBBS seat increase proposal to the Board of Governors, MCI should be received in the Council office not later than 15th May, 2019.
