- 1. There is no Statistician cum Lecturer in the department.
- 2. There is deficiency of 1 Assistant Professor.
- 3. Dr. G. Chaitanya, Asstt.Prof. does not possess recognized PG qualification.
- 4. Resultantly, teaching faculty component is inadequate.
- 5. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

11. <u>Starting of MD (DVL) & DDVL at Dr. Pinnamaneni Siddhartha Institute of</u> <u>Medical Sciences & Research Foundation, Krishna Distt. (A.P.) u/s 10 A of the</u> <u>Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.</u>

Read: the compliance verification inspection report along with compliance and Council Inspector's report (Feb. 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Dr. Pinnamaneni Siddhartha Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Foundation, Krishna Distt. Under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada for starting of MD (DVL) & DDVL courses u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification inspection report along with compliance and Council Inspector's report (Feb. 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MD (DVL) & DDVL courses at Dr. Pinnamaneni Siddhartha Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Foundation, Krishna Distt. Under Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 1(one) student per year in each course, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said courses. The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and noted that Dr. Subin Krishnan, Asstt.Prof., Dr. Bijay Chiriyath, Asstt.Prof. and Dr. Arathi R. Asstt.Prof. , do not possess recognized PG qualification.

However, the Postgraduate Committee further noted that the teaching faculty complement, other than the teachers mentioned above, is adequate and complete; and hence, decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of Diploma in Anaesthesia course at Amrita School of Medicine, Kochi under Amrita Vishwavidyapeetam u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 6(six) students per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

13. <u>Starting of MD(Radiotherapy) at Father Muller's Institute of Medical</u> <u>Education and Research, Mangalore u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council</u> <u>Act, 1956.</u>

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore for starting of MD(Radiotherapy) course under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Radiotherapy) course at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore because of the following reasons:-

- 1. Average daily OPD is 15, which is inadequate.
- 2. Resultantly, clinical material is inadequate.
- 3. There is no Physicist in the department.
- 4. Facilities for intra-operative Radiotherapy and Radioactive isotope work are not available.
- 5. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

14. <u>Starting of MD (Pulmonary Medicine) at Deccan College of Medical Sciences,</u> Hyderabad, u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad for Starting of MD(Pulmonary Medicine) course under Dr. N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for starting of MD(Pulmonary Medicine) course at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad under Dr. N.T.R. University of Health Sciences, Vijaywada because of the following :-

- 1. Average daily OPD is 40, which is inadequate.
- 2. Resultantly, clinical material is inadequate.
- 3. The department does not have TB Health Education Officer, Medical Social Worker and Laboratory Technician.
- 4. Facilities for lung resection and thoracoplasty are not available.
- 5. Resultantly, infrastructure is inadequate.
- 6. Facilities for Bronchography and computerized pulmonary function tests are not available.

- 7. Resultantly, instrumentation is inadequate.
- 8. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

15. <u>Starting of MD (Ophthalmology) & D.O. at N.R.I.Medical College, Guntur,</u> u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

Read: the compliance verification inspection report along with compliance and Council Inspector's report(Feb., 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at NRI Medical College, Guntur under NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada for starting of MS(Ophthalmology) & D.O. courses u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification inspection report along with compliance and Council Inspector's report (Feb., 2009) and noted that Dr. Swapna Vishal, Asstt.Prof. does not possess recognized postgraduate qualification.

However, the Postgraduate Committee further noted that the teaching faculty complement, other than the teachers mentioned above, is adequate and complete; and hence, decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for starting of MS(Ophthalmology) & D.O. courses at NRI Medical College, Guntur under NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 restricting the number of admission to 2(two) students for MS(Ophthalmology) and 1(one) student for DO course per year, till the first batch admitted appears in the final examination of the said courses. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualifications at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

16. <u>Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) at Father Muller's Institute of Medical</u> <u>Education and Research, Mangalore u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council</u> <u>Act, 1956.</u>

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore for Increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD(Paediatrics) course at Father Muller's Institute of Medical Education and Research, Mangalore under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore because of the following :-

- 1. Average daily OPD is 85.
- 2. Bed occupancy is 60%.
- 3. There is less number of critically ill patients.
- 4. Resultantly, clinical material is inadequate.
- 5. Dr. K. Sreedhara Avabratha Assoc. Prof., Unit-I does not possess recognized PG qualification.
- 6. Dr. Habeeb Ullah Khan, Assoc.Prof., Unit II, does not possess prescribed academic qualification.
- 7. There is no Senior Resident in the department.

8. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MD(Paediatrics) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

17. <u>Increase of seats in MD (General Medicine) at Dr. S. N. Medical College,</u> <u>Jodhpur u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.</u>

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Dr. S. N. Medical College, Jodhpur for increase of seats in MD (General Medicine) course under Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to advise the institution authorities to re-organize the beds vis-à-vis units as per MCI norms.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the information is received.

18. <u>Increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) at Medical College,</u> <u>Thiruvananthapuram, u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.</u>

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram for Increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) course under University of Kerala u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD(Community Medicine) course at Medical College, Thiruvananthapuram under University of Kerala because of the following:-

- 1. Promotion of Dr. T.Mathew, Professor, is not as per MCI norms.
- 2. Dr. Indu P.S., Assoc.Prof., does not possess prescribed academic qualification.
- 3. There is deficiency of 2 Associate Professors.
- 4. Resultantly, teaching faculty component is inadequate.
- 5. Other deficiencies/observations as pointed out in the inspection report.

In view of above, the Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in MD(Community Medicine) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

19. <u>Increase of seats in MD (General Medicine) at Mahatama Gandhi Medical</u> <u>College & Research Institute, Pondicherry u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical</u> <u>Council Act, 1956.</u>

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Mahatama Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute, Pondicherry for Starting of MD(General Medicine) course under Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth, Pondicherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MD(General Medicine) course at Mahatama Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute, Pondicherry under Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth, Pondicherry as the clinical material is just adequate for the present intake of 5 (five) students per year.

20. <u>Shivaji University and now by Krishna Instt. of Medical Sciences, (Deemed University) Karad - Recognition of M.D.(Physiology) qualification in respect of students being trained at Krishna Instt. of Medical Sciences, Karad.</u>

Read: the Council's Inspector's report (October, 07) together with inspection report (November, 95) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Krishna Instt. of Medical Sciences, Karad for purpose of recognition of M.D.(Physiology) qualification granted by Shivaji University and now by Krishna Instt. of Medical Sciences, (Deemed University) Karad.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council's Inspector's report (October, 07) together with inspection report (November, 95) and decided to recommend that M.D.(Physiology) qualification granted by Shivaji University and now by Krishna Instt. of Medical Sciences, (Deemed University) Karad in respect of students being trained at Krishna Instt. of Medical Sciences, Karad be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admission to 1 (one) student per year.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

"……

- 6.4 The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- 6.6 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-cluase-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course."

21. <u>Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur – Approval of J.L.N.Medical</u> <u>College, Ajmer for the award of M.D.(Psychiatry) qualification.</u>

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at J.L.N. Medical College, Ajmer for the award of M.D.(Psychiatry) qualification granted by Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend that J.L.N. Medical College, Ajmer be approved for the award of M.D.(Psychiatry) qualification granted by Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur restricting the number of admissions to 1(One) student per year.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment)

Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

"……

- 6.4 The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- 6.6 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-cluase-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.

22. <u>Increase of seats in MD(Obst. & Gynae.) at Government Medical College,</u> <u>Chandigarh u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.</u>

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Government Medical College, Chandigarh for increase of seats in MD(Obst. & Gynae.) course under Punjab University u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to advise the institution authorities to re-organize the teaching faculty vis-a-vis units as per MCI norms.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the information is received.

23. <u>Increase of seats in MD(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) at Mahatama</u> <u>Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute, Pondicherry u/s 10 A of the</u> <u>Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.</u>

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Mahatama Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute, Pondicherry for Increase of seats in MD(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course under Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth, Pondicherry u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. to issue Letter of Permission for increase of seats in MD(Dermatology, Venereology & Leprosy) course at Mahatama Gandhi Medical College & Research Institute, Pondicherry under Sri Balaji Vidyapeeth, Pondicherry u/s 10A of the I.M.C. Act, 1956 prospectively i.e. from the academic session 2010-2011 from 1(one) to 2(two) students per year till the first batch admitted against the increased number appears in the final examination of the said course. The institution be advised to apply for recognition of the qualification for the additional increased intake at the time of first available examination as per the provision of Section 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956.

24. <u>Increase of seats in MS (Ophthalmology) at NKP Salve Institute of Medical</u> <u>Sciences, Nagpur u/s 10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.</u>

Read: the Council Inspector report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at NKP Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur for increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector report (September 2009) and decided to recommend to the Central Govt. not to issue Letter of Intent for increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course at NKP Salve Institute of Medical Sciences, Nagpur under Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik because the clinical material is just adequate for the present annual intake of 1(one) student for MS (Ophthalmology) and 1(one) student for DO course.

25. <u>Increase of seats in MD (Physiology) at Dr. S. N. Medical College, Jodhpur u/s</u> <u>10 A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.</u>

- 2. Dr.K.Ghosh, shown as Professor and Dr.Manisha R Madkaikar, shown as Assoc. Prof. and also shown as employee of ICMR as Director and Asstt. Director respectively; which shows that they are not full time teacher of the institute.
- 3. Resultantly, teaching faculty component is incomplete.

In view of above, the Postgraduate Committee further decided to direct the institution authorities to henceforth stop admission in DM(Clinical Haematology) course from the academic session 2010-2011.

Read: the Council Inspector's report (September 2009) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Vydehi Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Bangalore for increase of seats in MS(Ophthalmology) course under Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council Inspector's report (September 2009) and decided to advise the institution authorities to re-organize the units in respect of teaching faculty as per MCI norms.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided to defer the consideration of the matter till the information is received.

118. <u>Rajasthan University & Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur –</u> <u>Approval of J.L.N. Medical College, Ajmer for the award of M.D.(Physiology)</u> <u>qualification.</u>

Read: the compliance verification report (Oct., 2009) together with the Council Inspector's report (September, 2004) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at J.L.N. Medical College, Ajmer for purpose of approval of the college for the award of M.D.(Physiology) qualification granted by Rajasthan University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (Oct., 2009) together with the Council Inspector's report (September, 2004) and decided to recommend that J.L.N. Medical College, Ajmer be approved for the award of M.D.(Physiology) qualification granted by Rajasthan University restricting the number of admissions to 1(One) student per year.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

"……

- 6.4 The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- 6.6 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-cluase-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.

119. <u>The Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai - Recognition of</u> <u>MD(Psychiatry) qualification in respect of students being trained at Christian</u> <u>Medical College, Vellore in respect of increased intake</u>

Read: the compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (March, 2009) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Christian Medical College, Vellore for purpose of recognition of MD (Psychiatry) qualification granted by the Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai in respect of increased intake.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance together with the Council Inspector's report (March, 2009) and noted that Christian Medical College, Vellore already stands recognized for the award of MD(Psychiatry) qualification with 2(Two) seat and now the matter is under consideration for recognition of the qualification against the increased intake from 2(Two) to 3(Three) seats; and decided to recommend that MD (Psychiatry) qualification granted by the Tamilnadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai in respect of students being trained at Christian Medical College, Vellore be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admissions to 3(Three) students per year.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

6.6 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-cluase-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.

^{6.4} The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.

120. <u>Nagpur University, RTM University Nagpur & Maharashtra University of</u> <u>Health Sciences, Nashik - Approval of Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical</u> <u>Sciences, Sewagram, Wardha for the award of MD(Radio-Diag.) & DMRD</u> <u>qualifications.</u>

Read: the compliance verification report (September, 2009) togetherwith the Council Inspector's report (Dec.,2005) on the physical and other teaching facilities available at Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Wardha for the approval of the course for MD(Radio-Diagnosis) & DMRD courses earlier granted by Nagpur University & RTM University and now by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (September, 2009) together with the Council Inspector's report (Dec., 2005) and noted that Dr. S.K. Kale, Professor, & Dr. G.Turkar, Assistant Professor, do not possess recognized postgraduate qualification.

However, the teaching faculty complement other than the teacher mentioned above is adequate and complete; and hence decided to recommend that Mahatma Gandhi Institute of Medical Sciences, Wardha be approved for the award of MD(Radio-Diagnosis) & DMRD courses earlier granted by Nagpur University & RTM University and now by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik restricting the number of admissions to 2(Two) students in MD(Radio-Diagnosis) & 2(Two) students in DMRD per year prospectively i.e., from the academic session 2010-2011 commensurate with available postgraduate teachers.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

- 6.4 The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (Oct., 2009) together with the Council Inspector's report (June,2009) and decided to recommend that Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad be approved for the award of

M.D.(Anesthesiology) qualification granted by Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut restricting the number of admissions to 4(Four) students per year.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (Oct. 2009) together with the Council Inspector report (May,2009) and noted that promotion of Dr. Asish Sharma, Professor, Unit-I, is not as per Regulations, as he has been promoted as Professor with experience of only 3 years as Associate Professor against requirement of 4 years.

However, the teaching faculty complement other than the teacher mentioned above is adequate and complete; and hence decided to recommend that Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad be approved for the award of M.D.(General Medicine) qualification granted by Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut restricting the number of admissions to 4(Four) students per year.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance verification report (Oct. 2009) together with the Council inspector report (July,2009) and decided to recommend that Santosh Medical College, Ghaziabad be approved for the award of M.S.(General Surgery) qualification granted by Ch. Charan Singh University, Meerut restricting the number of admissions to 4(Four) students per year.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the attention of the institute be drawn to Clauses 6.4 and 6.6 of the Postgraduate Medical Education (Amendment) Regulations, 2000, Part-II, dated 21st July, 2009 and act accordingly at appropriate time, which reads as under:-

"……

- 6.4 The recognition so granted to a Post Graduate Course shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.
- 6.6 Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-cluase-4 shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Post Graduate Course.
