#### 1. <u>Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee – confirmation of.</u>

The Postgraduate Committee confirmed the minutes of the Postgraduate Committee meeting held on 10<sup>th</sup> & 11<sup>th</sup> July, 2014.

#### 2. <u>Minutes of the last meeting of the Postgraduate Committee – action taken thereon.</u>

The Postgraduate Committee noted that the minutes have been confirmed today itself and section is directed to take the action on the minutes and place the action taken report before the next meeting.

#### 3. <u>Vinayaka Mission's University, salem - Recognition of MD(Radiodiagnosis) qualification in respect of students being trained at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Puducherry.</u>

Read: the assessment report (29.04.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Radiodiagnosis) qualification at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Puducherry granted by Vinayaka Mission's University, salem.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the assessment report (29.04.2014) and decided not to recommend recognition of MD(Radiodiagnosis) qualification granted by Vinayaka Mission's University, Salem in respect of students being trained at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College Hospital, Puducherry because of the following:-

- 1. There is no DSA facility available.
- 2. Daily MRI in the entire hospital are only 4 per day.
- 3. Daily FNAC in the entire hospital only 5 per day. This suggests grossly deficient clinical material
- 4. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.
- 4. <u>Vinayaka Mission's University, Salem Recognition of MS(ENT)</u> qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats in respect of students being trained at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Puducherry.

Read: the assessment report (28.04.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MS(ENT) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Puducherry granted by Vinayaka Mission's University, Salem.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (28.04.2014) and decided to recommend that MS(ENT) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats granted by Vinayaka Mission's University, Salem in respect of students being trained at Aarupadai Veedu Medical College & Hospital, Puducherry be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of notification upon which the institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (27.05.2014) and decided not to recommend recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) qualification against increased intake from 04 to 07 seats granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore because of the followings:-

- 1. There is no Asso. Prof. in Unit I.
- 2. There are 7 Units but all the Units have only 2 faculty each; resultantly none of the Unit has the full complement of 3 faculty required for PG Unit.

- 3. Total 17 Residents are shown in 7 Units but the categorization into Senior & Junior Residents is not shown.
- 4. No MRI in Bowring Hospital.
- 5. No Histopathology and no blood used in the last three years.
- 6. Indian and foreign journals available upto Dec. 2012.
- 7. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.
- 11. Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore Recognition of MD(General Medicine) qualification against increased intake from 09 to 19 seats in respect of students being trained at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore.

Read: the assessment report (20.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(General Medicine) qualification against increased intake from 09 to 19 seats at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (20.05.2014) and decided not to recommend recognition of MD(General Medicine) qualification against increased intake from 09 to 19 seats granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore in respect of students being trained at Bangalore Medical College and Research Institute, Bangalore because of the followings:-

- 1. Promotion of Dr. K. Ravi, Prof. Unit-IV is not as per Regulations. He has been Asstt. Prof. for 3 years 9 months.
- 2. There is shortage of 7 Senior residents.
- 3. No MRI in Bowring Hospital.
- 4. ICCU is not available.
- 5. Equipment for TMT, PFT and Endoscopy not available.
- 6. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.
- 12. <u>Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualfication against increased intake from 04 to 05 seats in respect of students being trained at Dayanand Medical College, Ludhiana.</u>

Read: the assessment report (02.06.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualfication against increased intake from 04 to 05 seats at Dayanand Medical College, Ludhiana granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (02.06.2014) and decided to recommend that MD(Paediatrics) qualfication against increased intake from 04 to 05 seats granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot in respect of students being trained at Dayanand Medical College, Ludhiana be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (20-21.05.2014) and decided to recommend that MD(Social & Preventive Medicine/Community Medicine) qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, A.P. in respect of students being trained at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956 restricting the number of admission to 2 (Two) students per year.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of notification upon which the institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course.

### 16. <u>Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, A.P. - Renewal of recognition of DLO qualification in respect of students being trained at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad.</u>

Read: the assessment report (20.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Renewal of recognition of DLO qualification at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, A.P.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (20.05.2014) and decided not to recommend Renewal of recognition of DLO qualification granted by Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, A.P. in respect of students being trained at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad because of the following:-

- 1. Departmental library is inadequate. There are only 50 books.
- 2. Instruments are inadequate. OAE is not available. Fiberoptic endoscopy & Oesophageoscopy facilities are not available.
- 3. Dr. P.N.S. Murthy was one of the internal examiners, but he has only 7 y 6 m experience as faculty which makes him ineligible to be an examiner as experience of 8 y is required as per Regulations.
- 4. Microscope for temporal bone lab was non-functional.
- 5. Audiometry room is not sound proof.
- 6. There is no separate room for speech therapy and Audiologist is working as Speech Therapist also.
- 7. Major O.T. Runs only twice a week. No major head & neck surgeries are being done.
- 8. There is no dressing room in ward.
- 9. Microscope in O.T. does not have camera attachment or observation tube; hence, PG students are not able to see surgeries being performed.
- 10. There is no departmental museum.
- 11. There is no endoscope/Oesophagoscope and there is no research lab.
- 12. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

### 17. Dr. NTR University of Health Sciences, Vijayawada, A.P. - Recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats & renewal of recognition of D.Ortho qualification in respect of students being trained at Deccan College of Medical Sciences, Hyderabad.

- 4. Minor OT entries in register could not be matched with indent from Minor O.T. in terms of instrument trays, surgical gloves, dressing trays, etc.
- 5. Bed occupancy on day of assessment was 33 %.
- 6. No cases were posted on day of assessment. Only 1 case of LSCS was posted. Entries in OT registers could not be correlated with concerned cases from MRD.
- 7. Operative workload is inadequate (Daily average of major operations is 2-3). SAF submitted shows workload of major cases as 10-12 & minor cases as 25-30 which could not be ascertained in assessment.
- 8. CSSD does not function as the CSSD room was totally empty and all the issuing registers are with dated and no entries at all.
- 9. Faculty members, especially Asst. Prof., Senior Residents & Junior residents were not there at the time of inspection of OPD, Department & O.T. But were there for head count.
- 10. Form 16 of some faculty was not in order as it did not have PAN. Payment details were not provided by the institute.
- 11. Radiological & laboratory workload is far less than claimed.

- 12. Library did not have enough print journals.
- 13. Unit 5 & 6 have only 2 faculty each; hence they cannot be considered as PG Units.
- 14. Deficiency of faculty is: (a) Asso. Prof.: 1 & (b) Asst. Prof.: 1.
- 15. Shortage of Residents is: (a) Senior Resident: 1; (b) Junior Resident: 1.
- 16. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

- 4. Promotion of Dr. Kamala Sharma, Asso. Prof. is not as per Regulations as she has been promoted as Asso. Prof. with experience of only 4 y 2 m as Asst. Prof.
- 5. Two Assoc. Profs. i.e. Dr. Dinesh Kumar and Mrs. Saibil Kumari joined only five days prior to assessment. They could not be involved in any manner in the teaching of the students.
- 6. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

- 1. Blood Units consumed in the department during the year 2012 were only 15 and in the year 2013, only 32 units that means only 1 to 2 units per month which indicate very low clinical material.
- 2. One of the External examiner was retired Professor and his bio-data is not supplied.
- 3. It has been consistently observed that the institute appoint only one Internal Examiner from the institute despite availability of eligible examiners in the department which may be clarified.
- 4. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

Hospital does not fulfill the requirements laid down in Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 (Amendment, 2005) dated 16/03/2005. Even if the Committee analyse the present report, the following deficiencies are also pointed out:

- 1. Deficiency of faculty for PG: (a) Asst. Prof.: 1. (It should have faculty for 50 MBBS intake + additional component for PG).
- 2. Promotion of Lt Col (Dr.) Sunita Das, Professor & HOD as Asso. Prof. is not as per Regulations as she has been promoted as Asso. Prof. with experience of only 1 y 4 m as Asst. Prof. (Experience as Senior Resident / Asst. Prof. & as Post MD Demonstrator / Lecturer cannot be equated with that of Asst. Prof.)

- 2. Ph.D. degree of Prof. Shanmugam J. from Moscow is not recognised and he cannot be counted as a faculty. Consequently, there is a deficiency of one Assoc. Prof.
- 3. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

- 1. Dr. Aditi Bhattacharya, Asso. Prof. has more than 11 years' teaching experience in Pathology but not in department of IHBT or adequate experience in blood bank.
- 2. Dr. Prasun Bhattacharya, one of the internal examiners is not eligible to be appointed as an examiner as he has experience of only 4 y 2 m as Asst. Prof. Against requirement of 8 y as per Regulations. (Summary)
- 3. Thesis has been examined by 4 external examiners but only one of them (Dr. Tathagat Chaterjee) holds recognized PG qualification in the subject; rest 3 are Professors of Pathology.
- 4. No evidence of special training in the department of IHBT to any faculty member has been produced.
- 5. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

- 4. Surgical component for minor surgical rehabilitation procedures should also exist in the department.
- 5. Activities of Journal Club need to be increased. There is no supply of journals in the departmental library.
- 6. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

- 2. The designation of Head of Unit 2, Dr. Ruth Yonzon, is "In charge" which is not an accepted nomenclature. She possesses academic qualification of only M.B;B.S. and hence not eligible for any faculty post; resultantly, faculty complement of Unit 2 is not complete. (P. 16)
- 3. Average daily OPD at own hospital of college is only 63 which is inadequate.
- 4. There is no separate PICU. It is a part of MICU. MICU staff looks after PICU.
- 5. Thalassemia management clinic is not available.
- 6. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (26.04.2014) and decided not to recommend recognition of MS(Orthopaedics) qualification granted by West Bengal University of Health Sciences, Kolkata in respect of students being trained at Vivekananda Institute of Medical Sciences, Kolkata because of the following:-

- 1. Dr. Tapas Chakravarty, Professor & Dr. P.K. Pujari, Asso. Prof. In the Unit running M.S. (Orthopaedics) course have all their experience at this institute which never had M.B;B.S. Course and M.S. Course was permitted from 2011-2012 only. There is no evidence to prove that this was a teaching institute before that.
- 2. There are two Units in Orthopaedics with 30 beds each. One Unit is running M.S.(Orthopaedics) course while the second Unit is running DNB course.
- 3. There are no publications from the department in indexed journals in last 3 years.
- 4. Average Histopathological load from the department is only 1-2/month which is inadequate.
- 5. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

The institute is running DNB courses which should be discontinued.

## 132. HIHT University, Dehradun - Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats in respect of students being trained at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun.

Read: the assessment report (05.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun granted by HIHT University, Dehradun.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (05.05.2014) and decided not to recommend recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 03 seats granted by HIHT University, Dehradun in respect of students being trained at Himalayan Institute of Medical Sciences, Dehradun because of the following:-

- 1. The Emergency department is mainly geared for older patients and Paediatric services and needs improvement in Casualty. Paediatric doctors are on call and not present in casualty all the time.
- 2. PICU also needs improvement in the number of beds available (there are only 2 beds) and protocol followed.
- 3. Waste management system in the department also needs to improve.
- 4. On day of assessment, the ward was filled up with cold cases which were OK for examination purpose but did not require admission E.g. Cases of Cerebral Palsy, Developmental Delay, Congenital Cardiac Disorders, etc. Only about 10-12 cases were present who genuinely required admission.
- 5. In the faculty statement, Unit 2 has 3 faculty, but one of the Asst. Prof., viz., Dr. Anurag Rawat has been shown against Senior Resident in which case there would be only 2 faculty; resultantly it cannot be considered as PG Unit.
- 6. Shortage of Senior Residents: 2.
- 7. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.
- 133. Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik Renewal of recognition of MD(DVL) qualification and recognition against increased intake from 1 to 2 seats in respect of students being trained at Institute of Navel Medicine, INHS, Aswini.

Read: the assessment report (31.05.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Renewal of recognition of MD(DVL) qualification and recognition against increased intake from 1 to 2 seats at Institute of Navel Medicine, INHS, Aswini granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (31.05.2014) and decided to recommend that MD(DVL) qualification and recognition against increased intake from 1 to 2 seats granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at Institute of Naval Medicine, INHS, Aswini be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of notification upon which the institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course.

# 134. Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik - Recognition of MD(Physiology) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 04 seats in respect of students being trained at Armed Forces Medical College, Pune.

Read: the assessment report (02.06.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Physiology) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 04 seats at Armed Forces Medical College, Pune granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (02.06.2014) and decided to recommend that MD(Physiology) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 04 seats granted by Maharashtra University of Health Sciences, Nashik in respect of students being trained at Armed Forces Medical College, Pune be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (28.05.2014) and decided to recommend that MD(Radio Diagnosis) qualification against increased intake from 01 to 02 seats granted by Krishna Institute of Medical

Sciences University(Deemed), karad in respect of students being trained at Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of notification upon which the institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course.

137. Bharath University, Chennai - Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 05 to 06 seats in respect of students being trained at Sree Balaji Medical College & Hospital, Chennai.

Read: the assessment report (17.04.2014) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 05 to 06 seats at Sree Balaji Medical College & Hospital, Chennai granted by Bharath University, Chennai.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the Council assessor's report (17.04.2014) and decided not to recommend recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification against increased intake from 05 to 06 seats granted by Bharath University, Chennai in respect of students being trained at Sree Balaji Medical College & Hospital, Chennai because of the following:

- Theory question papers did not appear vetted by university properly before issue e.g. Paper II (a) Psycho-social in Adolescents; (b) Abbreviations too many – FBNC, RNTCP, RDS
- 2. Theory question paper does not reflect adequately assessment on certain important aspect of Pediatric Training (Intensive Care, Clinical genetics).
- 3. Evaluation of M.D., Students I Pediatric Intensive Care and Emergencies as part of the Exit Examination not optimal.
- 4. The spectrum of cases kept in Neonatal section for the M.D. examination was confined only to Term neonates. This is not a strong mix of cases to evaluate students.
- 5. There is no dedicated PICU to train the 6 students. As part of Hospital CCU, only two beds were shown.
- 6. Date Sheet on statistics from September December 2013 in Pediatrics Emergencies, PICU and NICU were not made available despite requests to the concerned doctors.
- 7. The Junior Faculty and Residents assembled by Dean were leaving the hospital in a hurry even before the assessor completed hi assessment, it is, therefore, not clear if they are full time or part time staff.
- 8. Pertaining to Publication(s) of Faculty (PG Teachers), the Dean of the College submitted that this stipulation will be applicable only from date of Gazette Notification of the same. According to them, as this is not yet notified, this criterion will not be applicable to Professors already appointed.
- 9. Other deficiencies pointed out in the assessment report.

Read: the matter with regard to Inclusion of MD (Marine Medicine) in Schedule of Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000 along with the letter dated 10/11/2013 received from the Commanding Officer, INHS Asvini, Colaba, Mumbai along with the decision of the Sub-Committee.

The Postgraduate Committee deliberated upon the matter and decided to refer back to the Sub-Committee with the request that syllabus and eligibility of teachers should also be prescribed simultaneously before including the subject in the Schedule.

#### 153. Request for providing avenues for growth of Speciality of Laboratory Medicine in India.

Read: the request for providing avenues for growth of Speciality of Laboratory Medicine in India received from Dr. Rakesh Yadav, Sub Dean (Acad.), All India Institute of Medical Sciences, New Delhi vide letter dated 23/09/2013 along with the decision of the Sub-Committee.

Read: the compliance alongwith the assessment report (May, 2013) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at Father Muller Medical College, Mangalore for Recognition of MD(Paediatrics) qualification in respect of increased intake from 02 to 04 seats granted by Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Bangalore.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance alongwith the assessment report (May, 2013) and decided to verify the compliance by way of an assessment.

166(CR). Gujarat University, Ahmedabad - Recognition of M.Ch.(Surgical Oncology) qualification against increased intake from 04(Four) to 10(Ten) seats at B J Medical College, Ahmedabad.

Read: the compliance along with assessment report (July, 2013) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities for Recognition of M.Ch.(Surgical Oncology) qualification against increased intake from 04(Four) to 10(Ten) seats at B J Medical College, Ahmedabad granted by Gujarat University.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance alongwith the assessment report (September, 2013) and decided to recommend that DM(Gastroentrology) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 06 seats granted by Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur in respect of students

being trained at SMS Medical College, Jaipur be recognized and included in the 1st Schedule to the I.M.C. Act, 1956.

The Postgraduate Committee further decided that the recognition so granted shall be for a maximum period of 5 years from the date of notification upon which the institute shall have to apply for renewal of recognition. Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required shall invariably result in stoppage of admission to the postgraduate course.

Read: the compliance along with the assessment report (Sept., 2013) on the standard of examination and other teaching facilities available at SMS Medical College, Jaipur for Recognition of DM(Nephrology) qualification against increased intake from 02 to 04 seats granted by Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the compliance alongwith the assessment report (September, 2013) and decided to verify the compliance by way of an assessment.

#### 171. Carrying out pre-pg Assessment – regarding

Read: the matter with regard to carrying out pre-pg Assessment.

The Postgraduate Committee considered the matter with regard to carrying out pre-PG Assessment and noted that as per regulations "The Opening of a New or Higher Court of Study or Training (Including Post Graduate Course of Study or Training) and Increase of Admission Capacity in any course of Study or Training(Including a Post Graduate Course of Study of Study or Training), Regulations, 2000" and its amendment vide Gazette Notification dated 29.12.2009; decided and decided to carry out pre-PG assessment for all the institutions irrespective of the fact that they have already been permitted to start postgraduate courses in pre & para clinical subjects or not.

The committee further decided that with regard to application of colleges/institutions which have been recommended for recognition of their MBBS degree by the General Body of the Council, but the Gazette Notification by Govt. of India is still awaited decided to seek legal opinion from the Additional Solicitor General whether or not to consider such applications for academic year 2015-16.

### 172. <u>Application for Starting/Increase of Seats in Postgraduate course u/s 10(A) of IMC, 1956 for the Academic year 2015-16 consideration regarding.</u>

Read: the applications for Starting/Increase of Seats in Postgraduate courses u/s 10(A) of IMC, 1956 for the Academic year 2015-16.

The Committee decided to defer the consideration.

Dr. Raja Babu Panwar, Member recused himself from Item No. 173 since, his name has been mentioned in the Writ Petition.

#### 173. S.B .Civil writ petition no 8117/2011 in the matter of Dr. Yogendra Singh Gurjar & Anr. Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.-Reg.

Read: the S.B .Civil writ petition no 8117/2011 in the matter of Dr. Yogendra Singh Gurjar & Anr. Vs. State of Rajasthan & Ors.

The Postgraduate Committee discussed the legal opinion of Sr. Counsel Mr. Paramjeet Singh Patwalia and decided to agree with the opinion which is reproduced below:-

"A reading of the judgment of the Ld.Single Judge where reference is made to para 8.4 of the order of the Government of India dated 14.05.2003 would show that in fact it is implicit in the judgment that the students who have been admitted should be discharged from the course. However, at the same time the Division Bench order dated 12.5.2014 issues a direction to permit the appellant students concerned to appear in the examination of the Post Graduate course and to keep their result in a sealed cover. In this circumstances, for the present in my opinion this order permits the students to continue with the course for the reason that the final examination is the ultimate culmination of the academic course. Therefore, I am of the opinion that the Medical Council of India should defer taking a final decision on this issue in view of the order of the Division Bench and till such time as the DB Special Appeal is finally decided.

ii)

So far as the second query is concerned, the Ld. Single Judge has also directed the Medical Council of India to take up the matter against Respondent No.9 to 11 for violating the order of the Government of India, Notification of the Medical Council of India and the judgement of the Hon. Apex Court. The Ld. Single Judge holds the admissions made on the basis of the advertisement dated 27.5.2011 to be bad in law. In my opinion one possible action could be on the same lines as the Hon'ble Supreme Court has done in somewhat similar facts in the case of State of M.P. & Anr. Vs. Suresh Narayan Vijayvargiya & Ors – Contempt Petition (Civil) No.390 of 2011 in Civil Appeal No.4060 of 2009 dt. 27.2.2014. In that judgement the Hon'ble Supreme Court followed the view taken in the earlier decision of Mridul Dhar Vs. Union of India, particularly Direction 11 of the latter judgement which reads as under:

"The illegality committed must be set right at the earliest. This Court in Mridul Dhar (Minor) & Anr. V. Union of India & Ors. (2005)2 SCC 65, held (Direction No.11) as follows:

11. If any private medical college in a given academic year for any reason grants admission in its management quota in excess of its prescribed quota, the management quota for the next academic year shall stand reduced so as to set off the effect of excess admission in the management quota in the previous academic year."

Since the admissions for the Academic Session 2014-15 have already been made, the college can be directed to surrender equal number of seats against which it had made admissions which have now been held to be illegal by the Lt. Single Judge, in the Academic Session 2015-16."

The PG Committee further decided – since it is a Court matter, the minutes of Item No.173 be confirmed today itself, so that the decision may be communicated to the concerned authorities in the stipulated time period as per Court order.
