**PUBLIC NOTICE**

**Subject: Operationalization of NMC's Online Appeal Portal for Filing of Appeals by Medical Colleges/Institutions under various provisions of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019-reg.**

Attention of all Medical Colleges/Institutions is invited to the Public Notices dated 21.05.2024 and 30.05.2024 (copies enclosed) regarding filing of Appeals under the relevant provisions of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019, wherein the procedure for filing appeals through electronic mode and the prescribed appeal fee was prescribed.

2. In order to further streamline and digitize the appeal filing mechanism and to facilitate transparent, efficient and time-bound processing of appeals, the National Medical Commission has developed a dedicated Online Appeal Portal for filing of appeals by Medical Colleges/Institutions against the decisions of MARB/UGMEB/PGMEB under the various provisions of the National Medical Commission Act, 2019 and the Regulations framed thereunder.

3. Colleges may file Appeal by clicking on the Appeal icon or by logging in through their respective college login provided on the NMC website. Alternatively, they may access the online appeal portal directly at <https://application.nmc.org.in/login>.

4. Accordingly, it is hereby informed that with effect from the date of publication of this Public Notice, all Appeals under the National Medical Commission Act, 2019 shall be filed by Medical Colleges/Institutions exclusively through the Online Appeal Portal of NMC.

5. It has also been observed that appeals are often rendered deficient on account of filing under incorrect provisions of the Act, non-submission of requisite documents or filing before an incorrect authority. Stakeholders are, therefore, advised to carefully read the terms & conditions and User Manual available on the Online Appeal Portal before filing an appeal.

6. Consequent upon the operationalization of the Online Appeal Portal, the earlier mode of filing appeals through e-mail or any other mode/channel shall stand discontinued with immediate effect.

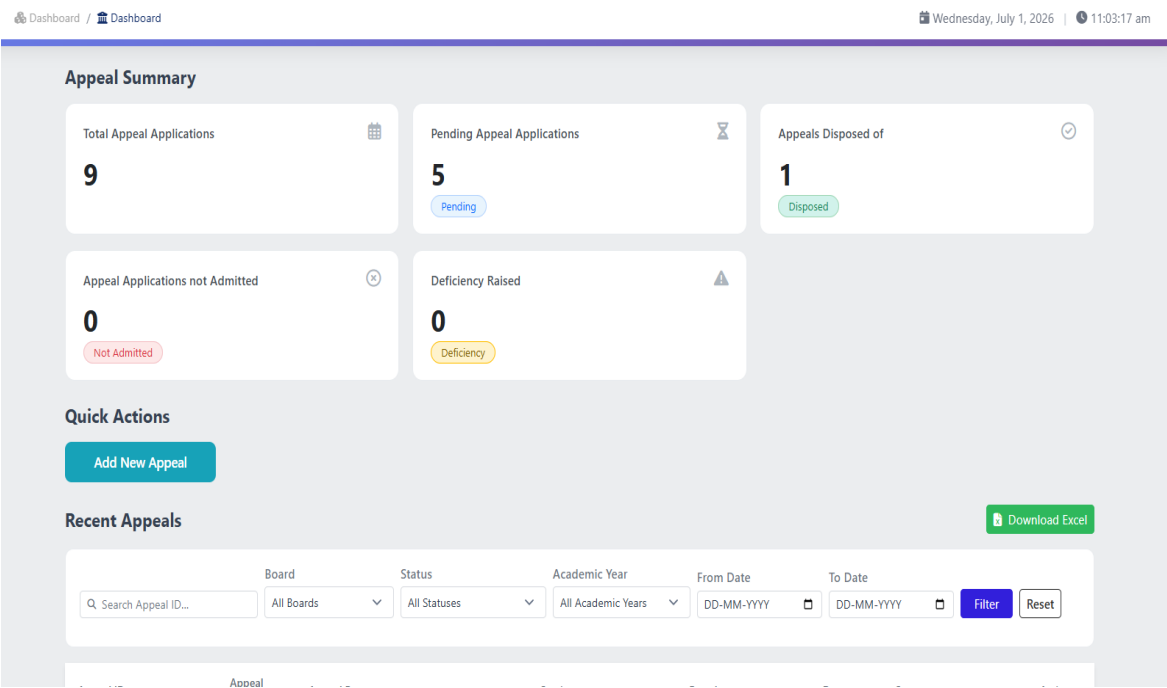

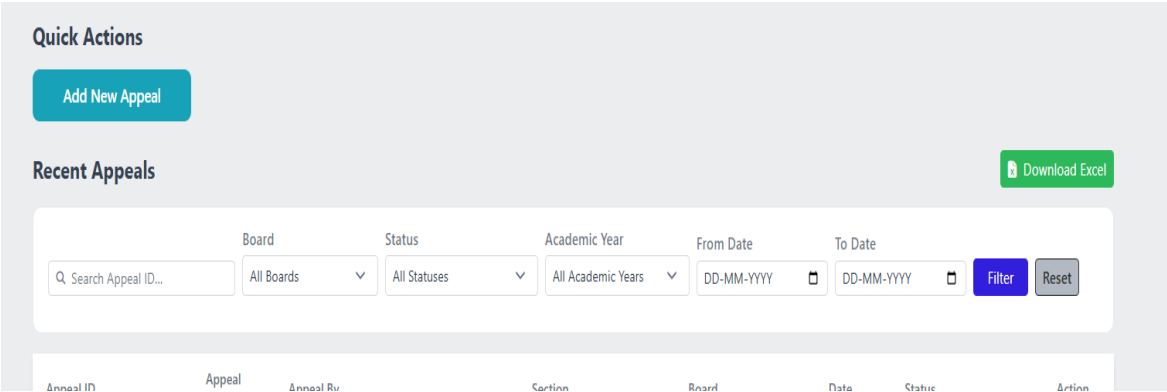

**Sub: Filing of 1<sup>st</sup>/2<sup>nd</sup> Appeals under relevant sections [u/s 22(3), 28(5), 30(4), 35(5)] of NMC Act, 2019 and appeal fee thereof.**

This Commission has earlier issued public notices dated 28.12.2022 and 28.08.2023 (copy enclosed) prescribing therein steps/ procedure for filing 1<sup>st</sup>/ 2<sup>nd</sup> appeals before the National Medical Commission (NMC) under the NMC Act, 2019.

2. Despite these guidelines, it has been observed that many colleges/ appellants are still not following the due procedure for filing appeals under the aforesaid sections of NMC Act as per said public notices. A number of appeals received in this Commission are deficient on various counts; invoking wrong section of the NMC Act; non-submission of all documents as per checklist prescribed in the public notice, appeal submission to non-concerned authority etc. which make them liable to be rejected on technical grounds.

3. In this regard, it is reiterated that all concerned may go through before submitting any appeal to this commission against decision of any board.

4. **The Commission in its 13th Meeting has decided to adopt a uniform fee of Rs. 50,000/- in cases of appeals filed by colleges/ Institutions related to academic year 2024-25 onwards and Rs. 5,000/- in all cases of appeals filed by Individuals. This will revise the different amounts of appeal fee earlier applicable for appeals in matter of different type of applications.**

5. **Further, it has also been decided that all appeals against the orders of the Boards under the Commission shall henceforth be addressed to Secretary, NMC only.**

6. Therefore, all concerned colleges/ appellants are hereby informed that all appeals against the orders of Boards under the Commission as provided under different sections of NMC Act, 2019 may be preferred via **ONLINE MODE ONLY** through email at '**nmc\_appeal@nmc.org.in**' and addressed to "**Secretary, NMC**" within the stipulated time period as per the NMC Act. Appeals received through any other mode/channel or email address will be liable not to be considered.

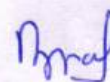

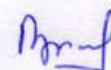
