In continuation of the notification dt. 2/9/2024 on the above mentioned subject, all the medical colleges/institutes may note the revision in the rates as well as the period of performance bank guarantees / e-PBG for the purposes detailed in the tabulation below:

Sl.No.	Purpose	Tenure/Rate
1.	Establishment of medical college For 50 admission of MBBS seats	6yr/ Rs. 15 Crores
2.	Establishment of medical college For 100 admission of MBBS seats (or Additional 50 seats of MBBS)	6yr/ Rs. 20 Crores (or Rs. 5 crores in case of additional 50 seats)
3.	Establishment of medical college For 150 admission of MBBS seats (or Additional 50 seats of MBBS)	6yr/ Rs. 25 Crores (or Rs. 5 crores in case of additional 50 seats)
4.	For PG degree / Higher Speciality*	4yr/ Rs. 2 Crores for first 4 PG seats.
5.	For additional PG degree / Higher Speciality seat	4yr/ Rs. 25 lakh per additional seat in that PG Course.

* There shall be no Bank Guarantee/ Electronic Bank Guarrantee for the following Post Graduate courses:

- i. MD (Aerospace Medicine)
- ii. MD (Anatomy)
- iii. MD (Biochemistry)
- iv. MD (Biophysics)
- v. MD (Community Medicine)
- vi. MD (Forensic Medicine & Toxicology)
- vii. MD (Health Administration)
- viii. MD (Hospital Administration)
- ix. MD (Marine Medicine)
- x. MD (Microbiology)
- xi. MD (Pharmacology)

- xii. MD (Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation)
- xiii. MD (Physiology)
- xiv. MD (Sports Medicine)

I further state that the decision taken by the national Medical Commission shall be final and binding on me.
