

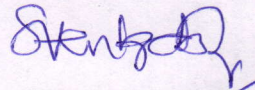

The tentative revised Time Schedule for online National Counseling Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Govt. of India the Post Graduate Super-Speciality courses 2019-20 issued by the Directorate General of Health Sciences indicates states that transfer of Non-Reporting and Non-Joining vacant seats to respective state/respective institute will be upto 12th September, 2019.

Accordingly, the on-line monitoring system opened for entry from 21st August 2019 for super-specialty postgraduate courses will be kept open for all the Medical colleges/Institutions to submit the admission details of Postgraduate Super-Speciality students latest by 16th September 2019. Beyond this date no Colleges/Institution will be allowed to enter the details of the students into Student Admission Online Monitoring System.

This year Colleges/Institutes need not send hardcopy of the data of admission to PG Courses. Data uploaded through the Student Admission Entry portal shall be the only data used for the purpose of monitoring students admission to PG courses. Hard Copies of student admission received by MCI Office will not be considered for the purpose of monitoring.

Madam/Sir,

In continuation of the MCI Circular dated 10.05.2019, this is to draw your kind attention that admissions in Postgraduate courses (DM, & M.Ch) has to be made in accordance with the provisions of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000. The Regulations framed by the Council have been held to be statutory, binding and mandatory in character by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in its various pronouncements.

2. The admission in various Postgraduate courses in Medicine the Medical College are required to ensure that the admission is in terms of the following parameters, based upon the judicial decisions and MCI Regulations:-
 - (i) All admission are made only and exclusively through the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance test (NEET) conducted by the National Board of Examination.
 - (ii) No admission is made beyond the sanctioned intake capacity.
 - (iii) Procedure for selection of candidates is in accordance with clause 9 of the Postgraduate Medical Education Regulations, 2000.
 - (iv) No admission is permitted beyond the cut-off date specified in Regulations/decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court.
 - (v) Students undergoing Postgraduate Super-specialty courses are paid stipend at par with the stipend being paid to the Postgraduate Super-Specialty students of State Government Medical Institutions / Central Government Medical Institutions in the State/Union Territory where the institution is located.
3. The Medical Colleges are required to ensure that all admission in courses of medicine fall within the purview of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and are strictly in accordance with merit and are made in a transparent and fair manner as envisaged in the Regulations. Any violation shall lead to discharge of the concerned student from the courses and such action against the concerned Medical College/Institution as is permissible in law.
4. In order to effectively monitor that all admissions made in courses of medicine are in conformity with the requirement of Regulations, an online monitoring system has been launched by the Council. This initiative is made with the objective of ensuring faithful adherence to the norms of admission laid down in Regulations as also to further promote transparency and accountability in the medical education.
5. Therefore, all the Medical Colleges/Institutions are called upon to submit the requisite information through the online system that can be accessed through Council website [<http://www.mciindia.org>]. You are required to submit the details of all the Students admitted PG Super-specialty during the current academic year 2019-20.

6. The On-line monitoring system will be open for entry from **21st August 2019** for Postgraduate Super-specialty courses. A unique login id will be provided to each college. Through this unique login id all the Medical colleges/Institutions must submit the admission details of Postgraduate Super-specialty students latest by **02nd September 2019** for super-specialty courses beyond which the Colleges/Institutions will not be allowed to enter the details of the students into Student Admission Online Monitoring System for this current academic year. This year Colleges /Institutes need not sent hardcopy of the data of admission in Postgraduate Super-specialty Courses. Data uploaded through the Student Admission Entry portal shall be the only data used for the purpose of monitoring students' admission to Postgraduate Super-specialty courses. **Hard Copies of student admission received by MCI Office will not be considered for the purpose of monitoring. No further extension of time will be given under any circumstances.**
7. **Non-receipt of this information within stipulated time will reflect on the recommendation to be made by the Council to the Central Government for grant of permission/recognition to the Colleges/Institutions for that academic year and/or subsequent academic years.**

 - xi. Name of the PG teacher under whom the student is admitted.
10. Kindly add the details of the Students according to the fields as mentioned above which will be available on the screen. Provision has been given to modify or delete any wrong entry by **02nd September 2019** for Super-specialty courses. No modifications will be allowed after the cutoff date.

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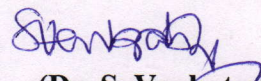

12. The onus of furnishing true, correct and authentic information is upon the College concerned and in case of furnishing of any wrong/incorrect information it shall be open to MCI to initiate action as is permissible in law.
